New this season:

There will be skating on **Thursday nights only**. Lessons will be 530-615p. Practice ice will be 615p-715p. The Tot program will need parent/adult skaters during their lesson time to help their skaters.

The club will be instituting a **badge program**. Badges will be awarded each time a test is passed.

With the success of the skaters at the ISI Worlds and continued interest of those skaters to compete, skating director Jen Kaminski has instituted a **competition team**. This will allow any skaters that wish to compete to have information about all upcoming events and Jen will assign a skating coach to the interested skater. Anyone wishing to compete should contact Sue Beauregard, and Jen will contact the skating family directly to discuss coaching needs for the skater's competition interests. Please be aware that all fees incurred are the responsibility of the skater. These fees include but are not limited to private coaching fees, skater practice ice time, competition registration fees, and competition coaching fees.
